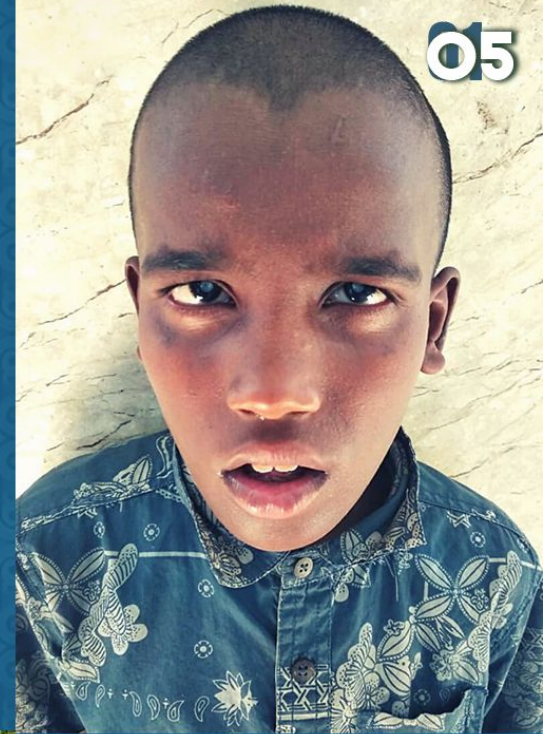

ABOUT TELEMEDICINE: This initiative is committed to delivering remote medical consultations and healthcare services, with a specific focus on individuals in underserved or remote areas. Through the utilization of telemedicine, SOUL strives to diminish disparities in healthcare access, elevate the quality of medical assistance, and promote the overall well-being of communities. By leveraging technology, the project seeks to establish efficient connections between patients and skilled healthcare professionals, ensuring timely and convenient healthcare delivery irrespective of geographical barriers.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:

- Provide accessible healthcare through mobile clinics.
- Connect remote areas with virtual consultations.
- Empower communities with quality healthcare and free medicines.

NO. OF BENEFICIARIES: 45000 Patients

IMPLEMENTATION: Implementation involved identifying patients and delivering treatment directly to them. A team comprising doctors and pharmacists was deployed to address the healthcare needs of these identified individuals.

PROGRAM EXPENSES: ₹ 5,18,751.36

MONITORING & EVALUATION PROCESS: In this process patients were contacted after a 7-day treatment period to gather feedback. This mechanism involved inquiring about improvements in their health and, if necessary, revising the prescribed medicines.

IMPACT: 85% patients in our feedback call confirmed that they are cured through our Telemedicine Seva Program.

CASE STUDY:



REBATI NAYEK

Rebati Nayek underwent a remarkable healthcare transformation through telemedicine. The expert and efficient treatment delivered remotely not only alleviated her health issues but also substantially enhanced her overall well-being. Rebati expresses profound gratitude, underscoring the pivotal role telemedicine services played in restoring her health. Now, she is thriving, emphasizing the positive impact of telemedicine in providing accessible and quality healthcare services to individuals.



ABOUT VIDYASHRAM: The residential accommodation, known as Project Vidyashram, has been established in the village specifically for Sabar kids, enabling their attendance at the local village school. This program offers a unique environment that not only supports their academic endeavors but also fosters physical development and provides access to computer services. Beyond conventional subjects, the children are immersed in a diverse curriculum that includes sports, farming, performing arts, and Indian mythology. This holistic approach aims to nurture well-rounded individuals, providing a comprehensive foundation for their growth and development. Ashalata, our student of Vidyashram is the first tribal girl to have passed Madhyamik in her community.

ABOUT THE BENEFICIARY COMMUNITY: The Sabar community, predominantly involved in occupations such as honey and crab collection, encounters threats from the Royal Bengal Tiger, crocodiles, and venomous snakes. Their historical challenges, marked by exploitation and a limited awareness of government aid, emphasize the critical need to understand and address these issues in order to support the community's development effectively.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

- Uplift first-generation learners.
- Address educational challenges for a brighter future.
- Leverage technology and vocational training for comprehensive education.

NO OF VIDYARTHIS: 50

AGE GROUP: 5 to 16 years [program designed especially for girl child]

MODE OF OPERATION: Residential

BENEFITS OFFERED: Academic assistance, food and accommodation, healthcare support and all the basic amenities are provided for their holistic development.

NO OF STAFFS: 6

MONITORING & EVALUATION PROCESS: The Monitoring & Evaluation Process evaluates Vidyarthis by combining school summative assessment scores, assessments by ashram tutors, and quarterly health checkups. Together, these components contribute to the thorough evaluation of Vidyarthis, taking into account both their academic progress and health development.

PROGRAM EXPENSE: ₹ 6,84,311.38

IMPACT: Ashalata Mullick has made history as the very first tribal girl in her community to have successfully passed the Madhyamik examination.

Ashalata Mullick, the first Savar girl to pass Madhyamik, overcame societal and economic barriers with SOUL's support. Her achievement not only marks personal triumph but inspires educational inclusivity within the Sabar community. Ashalata's journey is a beacon of hope for breaking generational constraints through education.





END HUNGER

ABOUT END HUNGER: SOUL's End Hunger initiative is dedicated to alleviating food insecurity using methods such as food distribution and the establishment of community gardens. By delivering healthy, freshly cooked meals to vulnerable populations in West Bengal, the project not only provides immediate relief but also contributes to long-term food security. This underscores SOUL's unwavering commitment to building a hunger-free society, focusing on fostering self-sustainability and enhancing community resilience.

PROGRAM STATUS: Ongoing

PROGRAM SUPPORTED BY: Individual Donors

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:

- Distribute healthy meals to tackle malnutrition effectively.

The process commences with the identification of beneficiaries, and subsequently, coupons are distributed to facilitate access. Following a daily routine, these kitchens efficiently prepare and deliver freshly cooked meals, ensuring that the nutritional needs of the beneficiaries are met with precision and care.

PROGRAM EXPENSES: ₹ 1,43,220

IMPACT: Amid challenging times, 95% of the beneficiaries, grappling with meal shortages, found relief through SOUL's provision of nutritious and wholesome meals, contributing to their active and healthy well-being.

ABOUT PRAYAS: Prayas is an innovative web-based virtual classroom offering synchronous instruction, connecting students and expert instructors in diverse fields. It provides learning opportunities and job interview preparation for youth in areas like Dance, Drawing, Spoken English, and various vocational roles.

RELIEF & DISASTER MANAGEMENT

ABOUT THE PROGRAM: The Disaster Management & Tiger Rescue Initiative focuses on addressing the urgent medical requirements of tribal individuals facing encounters with tigers. It provides financial aid for sustenance, tackles challenges for the overall well-being of the community, and extends its efforts to aid island residents. The initiative guarantees the delivery of essential supplies and imparts fundamental survival techniques, demonstrating its dedication to comprehensive disaster management and community welfare.

Amid the Yaas Cyclone, SOUL, under the Relief and Disaster Management Initiative, distributed cooked hot meals, along with providing utensils and clothing to the affected people. SOUL also distributed food to 67 families who were extremely affected due to flood in Patashpur of Medinipur.
